



C I R C U L A R

It has been brought into the notice of this Directorate that the students are being subjected to heavy book load as per prevailing time table fixed by various Educational Institutions particularly the Private Schools functioning in Srinagar and other Cities of Kashmir province. Even the issue has been highlighted in the print media, indicating that this kind of situation can lead to various ailments of children at younger age. This is a matter of serious concern and needs to be addressed immediately. Accordingly it is enjoined upon all the Heads of the Institutions particularly the Principals of Private Schools functioning in Srinagar and other Cities of Kashmir province to ensure that the time table is framed in such a manner that minimum book load is required to be carried by the students.

It is also advised that the Schools should work out a strategy whereunder the extra books may be retained in the Schools and be given to the students as and when required.

The compliance of above shall be intimated to this Directorate within 2-days positively, failing which action as warranted under rules shall be taken against deviants.
